The questions

Work them on paper first. Full solutions start after question 12 — the numbering matches.

QUESTION 1

4 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 4 the far right.

1. Kiran sits somewhere to the right of Geeta.
2. Deepak sits at the far-left (extreme) end of the row.
3. Gauri sits at the far-right (extreme) end of the row.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 2

4 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Lata faces north.
2. Tarun sits immediately to the left of Uma (both facing south).
3. Lata sits immediately to the left of Arjun (both facing north).

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

QUESTION 3

5 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 5 the far right.

1. Aditi sits immediately to the left of Chetan.
2. Chetan sits immediately to the left of Manish.
3. Priya sits somewhere to the right of Chetan.
4. Tarun sits somewhere to the right of Priya.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 4

6 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Meera faces south.
2. Geeta sits immediately to the left of Meera (both facing south).
3. Exactly 1 person sits between Geeta and Divya in the same row.
4. Karan sits 2nd to the left of Vikram (both facing north).
5. Gauri sits immediately to the left of Vikram (both facing north).

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

QUESTION 5

5 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 5 the far right.

1. Deepak sits somewhere to the right of Uma.
2. Exactly 1 person sits between Sneha and Uma.
3. Manish sits somewhere to the right of Uma.
4. Exactly 1 person sits between Rahul and Manish.
5. Manish sits somewhere to the left of Rahul.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 6

6 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Kiran does NOT sit directly opposite Anjali.
2. Kiran sits immediately to the left of Isha (both facing north).
3. Exactly 1 person sits between Anjali and Harsh in the same row.
4. Exactly 1 person sits between Nikhil and Kiran in the same row.
5. Isha faces north.
6. Anjali sits immediately to the left of Divya (both facing south).

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

QUESTION 7

4 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 4 the far right.

1. Priya sits immediately to the left of Imran.
2. Exactly 2 people sit between Imran and Sanjay.
3. Priya sits immediately to the right of Divya.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 8

4 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Chetan faces north.
2. Chetan sits immediately to the left of Harsh (both facing north).
3. Pooja sits immediately to the left of Aditi (both facing south).

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

QUESTION 9

5 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 5 the far right.

1. Zoya sits somewhere to the left of Tarun.
2. Exactly 1 person sits between Varun and Nikhil.
3. Zoya sits somewhere to the right of Pooja.
4. Nikhil sits at the far-right (extreme) end of the row.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 10

6 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Aditi faces north.
2. Isha sits immediately to the left of Harsh (both facing north).
3. Arjun sits 2nd to the left of Sneha (both facing south).
4. Aditi sits 2nd to the left of Harsh (both facing north).
5. Anjali faces south.

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

QUESTION 11

5 people sit in a row, all facing the same way — seat 1 is the far left, seat 5 the far right.

1. Tarun sits immediately to the left of Tanvi.
2. Tanvi sits immediately to the left of Karan.
3. Tarun sits somewhere to the left of Meera.
4. Exactly 2 people sit between Tarun and Aditi.

Can you work out who sits in each seat?

QUESTION 12

6 people sit in two parallel rows facing each other — one row faces north, the other faces south, and each person sits directly opposite exactly one other.

1. Imran does NOT sit directly opposite Tanvi.
2. Uma sits immediately to the left of Priya (both facing north).
3. Anjali sits immediately to the left of Meera (both facing south).
4. Imran sits immediately to the left of Anjali (both facing south).
5. Meera faces south.

Can you work out who sits in each seat, in both rows?

Answers and worked solutions

Each walkthrough is the engine's own elimination order, step for step — not a reconstruction written after the fact.

SOLUTION 1

1. Start: 24 possible left-to-right orders of 4 people.
 2. Clue 2 — "Deepak sits at the far-left (extreme) end of the row." $\Rightarrow$ Deepak $\rightarrow$ seat 1 (6 possibilities left). Board (left $\rightarrow$ right):

 3. Clue 3 — "Gauri sits at the far-right (extreme) end of the row." $\Rightarrow$ Gauri $\rightarrow$ seat 4 (2 possibilities left). Board (left $\rightarrow$ right):
Deepak $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ Gauri
 4. Clue 1 — "Kiran sits somewhere to the right of Geeta." $\Rightarrow$ Geeta $\rightarrow$ seat 2, Kiran $\rightarrow$ seat 3 (1 possibility left). Board (left $\rightarrow$ right): Deepak $\cdot$ Geeta $\cdot$ Kiran $\cdot$ Gauri
 5. Exactly one order survives every clue: Deepak, Geeta, Kiran, Gauri (left to right).
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SOLUTION 2

1. Start: 24 ways to seat 4 people in two facing rows of 2.
 2. Clue 1 — "Lata faces north." narrows it to 12 possibilities. Board — North (W $\rightarrow$ E): _ $\cdot$ _ | South (W $\rightarrow$ E): _ $\cdot$ _
 3. Clue 2 — "Tarun sits immediately to the left of Uma (both facing south)." $\Rightarrow$ Tarun $\rightarrow$ the south-facing row, column 2 (1 = west),
Uma $\rightarrow$ the south-facing row, column 1 (1 = west) (2 possibilities left). Board — North (W $\rightarrow$ E): _ $\cdot$ _ | South (W $\rightarrow$ E): Uma $\cdot$
Tarun
 4. Clue 3 — "Lata sits immediately to the left of Arjun (both facing north)." $\Rightarrow$ Arjun $\rightarrow$ the north-facing row, column 2 (1 = west),
Lata $\rightarrow$ the north-facing row, column 1 (1 = west) (1 possibility left). Board — North (W $\rightarrow$ E): Lata $\cdot$ Arjun | South (W $\rightarrow$ E):
Uma $\cdot$ Tarun
 5. Exactly one seating survives every clue — north row: Lata, Arjun; south row: Uma, Tarun.
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SOLUTION 3

1. Start: 120 possible left-to-right orders of 5 people.
 2. Clue 1 — "Aditi sits immediately to the left of Chetan." narrows it to 24 possibilities. Board (left $\rightarrow$ right): _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _
 3. Clue 2 — "Chetan sits immediately to the left of Manish." narrows it to 6 possibilities. Board (left $\rightarrow$ right): _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _ $\cdot$ _

 5. Clue 4 — "Karan sits 2nd to the left of Vikram (both facing north)." $\Rightarrow$ Karan $\rightarrow$ the north-facing row, column 1 (1 = west),
Vikram $\rightarrow$ the north-facing row, column 3 (1 = west), Gauri $\rightarrow$ the north-facing row, column 2 (1 = west) (1 possibility left).
Board — North (W $\rightarrow$ E): Karan $\cdot$ Gauri $\cdot$ Vikram | South (W $\rightarrow$ E): Divya $\cdot$ Meera $\cdot$ Geeta
 6. Exactly one seating survives every clue — north row: Karan, Gauri, Vikram; south row: Divya, Meera, Geeta.

 5. Clue 3 — "Manish sits somewhere to the right of Uma." narrows it to 4 possibilities. Board (left → right): _ · _ · _ · _ · Deepak
 6. Clue 5 — "Manish sits somewhere to the left of Rahul." ⇒ Rahul → seat 4, Manish → seat 2, Sneha → seat 3, Uma → seat 1 (1 possibility left). Board (left → right): Uma · Manish · Sneha · Rahul · Deepak
 7. Exactly one order survives every clue: Uma, Manish, Sneha, Rahul, Deepak (left to right).

 7. Exactly one seating survives every clue — north row: Kiran, Isha, Nikhil; south row: Harsh, Divya, Anjali.

 5. Exactly one order survives every clue: Sanjay, Divya, Priya, Imran (left to right).
